

## **Guide to Local Plan Policies: superseded and adopted**

The Core Strategy (2009), Site Specific Allocations & DM Policies (2012) and Delivering Poole's Infrastructure (2012) have all been superseded and replaced by a single Local Plan for Poole adopted November 2018.

The table below sets out a schedule of the superseded Plan policies and the current Local Plan policies that most closely replace them, additional information is also highlighted. *This table is intended to be used as a guide only and is not a definitive or exhaustive list.*
