



CONDITIONS OF USE

- On obtaining this Annual purchasing permit, you will then be able to purchase, use and top up your daily permit allocation by clicking on “Book Daily Visitor/Commuter Permits” on the main “My Account” page.
- Permits will only be valid for the vehicle registered at the time of the application.
- Physical permits will not be issued, instead a virtual permit will be assigned to you.
- The permits do not guarantee the availability of a parking place.
- The One Day Parking Permits are only valid for use within the Parking Zone applied for. Each permit allow 24 hours parking from the time requested, where the signs indicate a 2 hour limit and that permit holders are exempt.
- The permit will allow parking for 24 hours from the time purchased. Alternatively, you can book parking in advance and it will be valid for 24 hours from the date/time selected.
- The permits do not entitle you to park on yellow lines or other parking spaces.
- The permit is not valid for Poole Housing Partnership Land. These permits need to be obtained separately.
- No transfer or refund of any unused time will be processed.
- By applying you give us authorisation to check the Council Tax or Electoral Roll records to confirm your residence. If you are not named on these records you will need to supply further evidence of your residence e.g. Tenancy Agreement.
- The information I have given in this application is correct and complete. I understand that it is an offence to dishonestly make a false statement or produce false information (or cause or allow another to do so) or to misuse or allow my season ticket to be misused and that in such circumstances the Council may cancel my season ticket and prosecute me.
- The use of parking spaces may be suspended by Police Officers, Civil Enforcement Officers or duly authorised Council Officers.
- The user must ensure the vehicle is parked within the confines of the parking space.
- The council reserves the right to withdraw any permits found to have been improperly issued or misused.
- Contravention of the above conditions will invalidate the permit and the vehicle will be subject to the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice.
