



Bournemouth, Christchurch & Poole Council **Poole Tennis Scheme – Terms and Conditions**

1. Membership is for 1 year and will be activated upon submission of application. Your membership renewal date can be seen on your email – ‘Membership expires on’.
2. The access key code for the gate must not be passed onto other households.
3. Only tennis must be played on the courts. Football or any other activity is forbidden.
4. Courts may be booked up to 1 week in advance.
5. You may book 3 courts per week. If you want to play for longer and a court is free and not booked, then you can play on that court.
6. Appropriate tennis wear must be worn at all times (i.e. footwear and tops).
7. Please ensure you close the gate on entering and leaving.
8. If two people think they have booked the same court, please ring 01202 261306 and the persons name that appears on the computer will be the person allowed to play.
9. You are expected to conduct yourselves so that no other people are offended by your behavior or language.
10. Our staff have the right to ask any person misusing or behaving anti-socially on the courts to leave.
11. Transfer of membership from one location to another is not available.
12. BCP Council reserves the right to cancel the membership of any person who does not abide by these terms and conditions. No refund will be given.
13. If you notice any damage to the courts, please report this via the details below.
14. All players play on the courts at their own risk.
